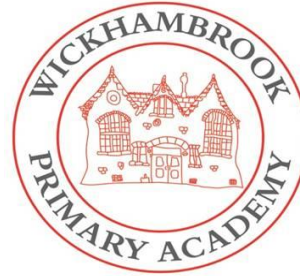


Wickhambrook Sports Premium Strategy 2020-2021

Bike/Balance Ability – Autumn term	£1200	To enable all EYFS children to use a balance bike and develop the skills they need to ride a bike for a 6-week course. To ensure that Year 5 children learn to cycle on the road in a safe an appropriate way. This is completed over the course of a week.	Very positive reports from parents about children’s bike riding skills once they had taken part in the 6-week course. Positive feedback from Year 5 cycling with all children passing both stages of the safety test – this is the first year all children have passed both stages.

Enhance gross motor skills on the playground and the field – Spring term	Unknown	To provide climbing opportunities on the field and more ball skill opportunities on the playground.
