

FAQs about Otto...



Will Otto just roam around the school? Absolutely not! Otto will be supervised by a responsible adult at all times. He will also have his crate in Mrs Tyzack's office where he can be secured if circumstances require.

How will the school fund Otto? All costs associated with Otto, including purchase, insurance, vet bills, equipment and food will be met personally by Mrs Tyzack. **The school will incur no costs at all...**just lots of fun!

Where are other dogs allowed on the school site? In order to maintain the integrity of Wickhambrook Primary Academy's Dog Risk Assessment and in line with our insurance policy, only Otto and registered disability assistance dogs are allowed in the building except in very particular circumstances with the express permission of the head teacher e.g. for training or socialisation purposes. Any dog in the building must meet the criteria set out in the policy and risk assessment.

What about people visiting school? There will be a very clear sign on the interior school front door that says Otto is in residence and directs anyone with allergies or anxieties relating to dogs to inform the office immediately.

Can we bring Otto gifts? Otto will have everything he needs and we don't want to spoil him, we are intending for him to be an exemplary member of our school.
